Saint Charles Church depends on your weekly support for operating expenses. Average weekly 2011-2012 budget needed is \$ 3,360.00



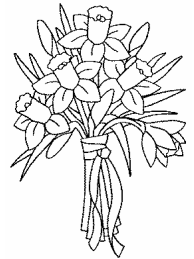
